

## OHS Advisory Board Special Meeting of 4/29/19 - MINUTES

The first ever, OHS Advisory Board Special “Zoom” meeting took place on 4/29/20. There were 18 voting Board members on the call and over 40 people total who participated.

Topics covered included the following:

1. Review of COVID-19 Summary: Weekly summary will be sent going forward.
  - Updates going forward
  - Planning for ongoing services

Much detail was provided concerning the hotels that have been established, the screening being done at shelters, and the hand washing and port-o-lets installed.

Questions were raised about testing and contact tracing of Positive tests. The County Board of Health and the City of Cleveland Dept. of Health are responsible for contact Tracing. Testing at shelters will take place in the coming weeks.

Conversations with providers concerning shelter services as restrictions are lifted are going forward.

2. Updates:
  - HMIS migration to Clarity: Migration will be completed in May with a “go live” date of June 1<sup>st</sup>.
  - RRH : placements are continuing during the Stay ay Home orders.
  - EVH: Veterans are being moved to hotels to reduce concentration in shelters.
  - Ending Youth Homelessness: A Place 4 Me submitted the required Planning document to the State. Implementation of the Ohio department of Health Grant is moving forward.
  - NOFA : CoC is waiting to hear how HUD will conduct the NOFA process this year.
